From North San Antonio:

Take 281 South (toward downtown)
Exit 35 South and stay in the Right lane
Take your 1st Exit – Brooklyn/McCullough and stay in the Right lane
Go through the light at Brooklyn and then me to the right one more lane.
Drive a little further and turn Left on Main.
Take your 1st Left onto Quincy.
Take your 1st Left onto Richmond (just after the entrance ramp to the highway)
Turn Right into the parking garage (the outside of the garage says "One Lexington Medical Building")

From South San Antonio:

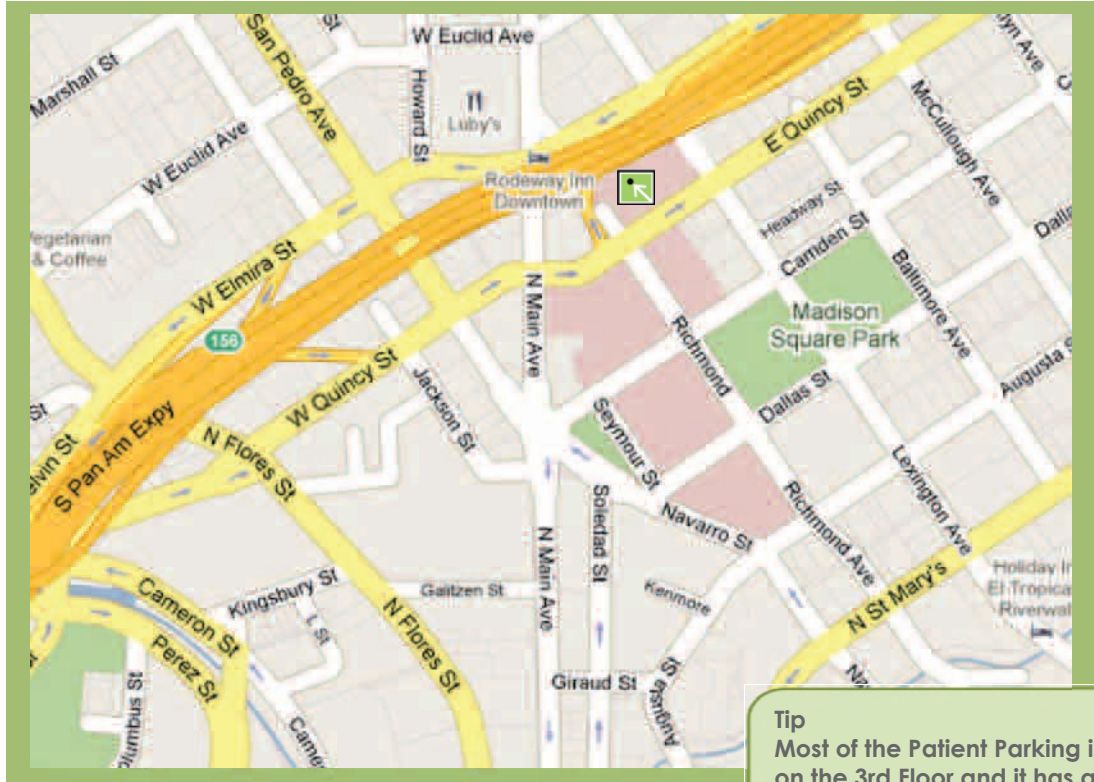
Take I-35 North toward downtown
Stay to the Left every time the highway splits
Exit San Pedro/Main/Lexington (Exit 157A)
The exit ramp turns into an access road – this is Quincy. Stay on Quincy.
You will see a parking garage ahead that says "One Lexington Medical Building"
Turn Left onto Richmond (just after the entrance ramp to the highway) just before that parking garage
Turn Right into the parking garage

From East San Antonio:

Take I-35 South toward downtown
When you get close to downtown and the highway splits, take the Left-hand split.
Take the 1st Exit after the highway splits which is Lexington/Main/San Pedro (Exit 157A)
Turn Left on Main.
Take your 1st Left onto Quincy.
Take your 1st Left onto Richmond (just after the entrance ramp to the highway)
Turn Right into the parking garage (the outside of the garage says "One Lexington Medical Building")

From West San Antonio (Medical Center):

Take I-10 East toward downtown
When the highway splits stay to the Right side of the split
Exit Santa Rosa (Exit 569C)
Stay in the Left lane
Take your 1st Left onto Quincy.
You will see a parking garage ahead that says "One Lexington Medical Building"
Turn Left onto Brooklyn (just after the entrance ramp to the highway) just before that parking garage
Turn Right into the parking garage.



Tip
Most of the Patient Parking is on the 3rd Floor and it has a crosswalk that leads over the road to Baptist Hospital!

Parking:

Park in the One Lexington Medical Building Parking Garage

Once in the Garage:

Once you are in the garage there is a private parking lot just to your right for Oncology San Antonio patients. If that lot is full, keep on driving!

Once in the Building:

Find the closest elevator and take it to Level B. Remember to write down the floor you parked on!

Bring your parking ket in with you. We will stamp it for you at the front desk so that you can park for free!
